Who is it for?

This qualification is aimed at key professionals and managers working in regulatory authorities, government departments and law enforcement agencies requiring a professional level of investigative practice.

There are no formal entry requirements.

How is it taught?

The qualification has 60 guided learning hours with an element of distance learning study included. Learners will attend a 4 day taught programme.

How is it assessed?

This qualification is about understanding, planning, organising and managing required professional investigative skills and techniques in organisations requiring a quality assured professional level of investigative practice. Consequently, assessment is through practical assignments, presentations, completed documentation, evidence portfolio and reflective logs.

What will I gain?

Once you've completed this qualification you will be able to:

- 1. Develop professional skills to support achievement of organisational objectives**
- 2. Determine proposed law enforcement actions**
- 3. Design law enforcement operations**
- 4. Organise media relationships**
- 5. Manage critical incidents and concerns**

Who is it for?

This qualification is aimed at first line supervisors, middle and senior managers working in regulatory authorities, government departments and law enforcement agencies requiring strategic management of complex investigations.

There are no formal entry requirements.

How is it taught?

The qualification has 80 guided learning hours with an element of distance learning study included. Learners will attend a 2 day taught programme.

How is it assessed?

This qualification is about the strategic management to direct investigative obligations and ensure a high quality and professional level of investigative procedures and operations. The successful management of ambiguous and complex investigations requires detailed design, planning, direction, control and critical evaluation. It also requires the strategic vision to ensure that required evidential outcomes are comprehensively and appropriately achieved. Consequently, assessment is through practical assignments, presentations, completed documentation, evidence portfolio and reflective logs.

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
